## **Initiation Ceremony Rubric**

The Initiation Ceremony rubric is a tool for volunteers who are verifying the "Initiation Ritual Well Performed" CMP requirement for a chapter. While this is not an exhaustive list of things to be considered, it will provide those verifying the well performance of the ceremony some guidance for approving the requirement. It will also assist chapters in providing a seamless and memorable experience for those being initiated.

Expectations of the verifier for approving the requirement should be discussed with the Ritual team prior to performing the ceremony. Approval of the requirement is at the discretion of the verifier.
